SIXTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME, JULY 18 - Luke 10:38-42.

What is each of the people in the gospel story doing? Martha is serving; Mary is listening; Jesus is teaching. While Jesus says that Mary has the “better part,” this doesn’t necessarily mean that listening to Jesus is either the only or the easier part. Listening to Jesus with a heart truly able to hear is difficult, indeed. Listening to Jesus is the “better part” only when it leads us to serve and teach as Jesus himself did. We tend to be “either – or” in our thinking. This is also how we tend to interpret this gospel. Jesus is not saying hospitality and serving is unimportant; he is inviting us to reflect on how and when we listen to him.

- When entertaining guests am I more like Martha or Mary? Why?
- When attending to my relationship with God, am I more like Martha or Mary? How?
- What do I understand the “better part” chosen by Mary to mean? What do I need to do to embrace this teaching of Jesus more deeply?
